Participate now

You will need:

- ך Your PRODA or myGovID login details
- Your national AHPRA registration or an active, 8-digit Medicare provider number
- Details of a nominated person to assist you to manage your account
-] Your primary practice address and fee information for one out-of-hospital service



Register and invite your practice staff

- 1. Access the Medical Costs Finder portal and log in, or access the portal in PRODA
- 2. Select and enter your national AHPRA registration or Medicare provider number
- 3. Select your AHPRA specialty
- 4. Consent to the terms of use and privacy notice
- 5. Enter details to invite your practice staff and click 'Next'

Build your public profile

- 1. Select your title and confirm your display name
- 2. Select your years of experience, fellowship(s) and qualification(s)
- 3. Enter your contact details (this will not be public), click 'Save and next'

Publish your first fee

- 1. Add your primary practice location
- 2. Add your first service and its indicative fee
- 3. Click 'Publish' and then 'Confirm'

Support staff can update information and send to the specialist or authorised representative for approval.
